Perfect love exists. It's the essence of God. Yet, we rarely experience this perfect or absolute love because all our relationships-- with parents, children, siblings, friends, lovers and spouses-- are flawed by the human condition.

We receive moments in life where we experience the grace of absolute love radiating through us. These are times when our hearts are fully open to God-- often while experiencing vulnerability with another person-- but they are never more than fleeting moments. Our imperfect hearts are more often vulnerable to fear and other character defects than they are to God's perfect love. So we quickly shutdown our hearts to avoid being hurt. Fear leads us to act from selfish motivations and a relative, or conditional, love.

Relative love is an "I love you if..." false love that leads to relationship breakdown. Old hurts and grievances, inadequate communication skills, emotional shutdown, lack of self-love or self-esteem, mistrust and fear all fuel conditional love. They place walls around our hearts that prevent us from experiencing perfect love, and distance us from our loved ones.

If you are experiencing relationship breakdown with a significant other it may be because you don't fully understand your own behavior. It's essential that we all understand why we do the things we do, or we will never understand the behavior of a lover or spouse. This retreat will provide spiritual insight to help you soften human flaws that hinder Perfect Love between couples.
