Its location, away from the noise and commotion of the city, is a natural setting for a retreat that brings us closer to the Divine and our own inner calling.

Rabbi Helen Cohn lives in Tucson where she offers Spiritual Direction. She completed the Spiritual Directors' Institute at the Mercy Center in Burlingame, CA. Greg Foraker also calls Tucson home and serves as Director of Adult Formation Ministries at St. Philip's In The Hills Episcopal Church. Greg completed training for Spiritual Direction at Washington Theological Union in Washington, DC. Both Helen and Greg are on the faculty of the Hesychia School for Spiritual Direction and are experienced retreat leaders.

The retreat begins at 5:00 pm Sunday afternoon, Oct. 25; (May 23, 2010), and concludes at 1:00 pm Tuesday, Oct. 27; (May 25, 2010). Contact the Redemptorist Renewal Center if you wish to extend your retreat.
